## *Senior, Veteran, and History Center*

**Supporting our seniors:** When the former Senior Center opened in 1985, there were 30 members. Today, with more than 800 paying members and over 200 programs, our seniors needed a revitalized facility. By supporting the Heritage Center, you are providing a recreation and resource building for the active and growing senior segment of our community.

**Serving our veterans:** Lakeville Yellow Ribbon is a community organization that provides support to area veterans of all ages and branches of service. By supporting the Heritage Center, you are providing a space where veterans and their family members can find camaraderie and resources, making an ongoing community commitment to this honored segment of our community.

**Sustaining our history:** The Lakeville Area Historical Society collects and preserves the local history and treasures of times gone by. By supporting the Heritage Center, you are giving the entire community the opportunity to experience and appreciate our community's past.

**Community rentals:** When not being used by the three partner organizations, some rooms in the Heritage Center are available for rentals, including the Heritage Banquet Room, the Atrium, kitchen, conference room, and activity rooms.
